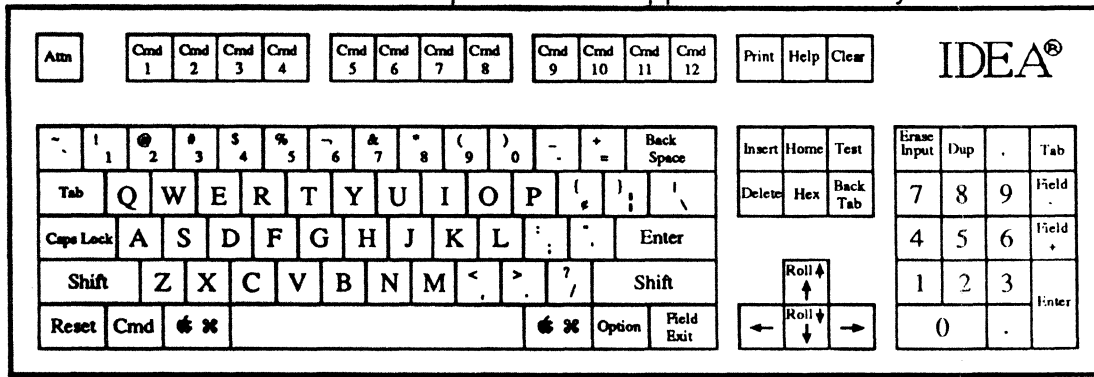
## Change In Key Locations

Please note that the Option key and Cmd key on the Apple Standard Keyboard have been swapped. The correct layout, which now has the Option key to the right and the Cmd key to the left, appears on the following page.

The Apple Extended Keyboard, which had the Option key to the right and the Cmd key to the left, remains unchanged.

In addition, as with IBM terminals, the Erase Input key on both the Apple Standard Keyboard and the Apple Extended Keyboard works when in shifted mode.

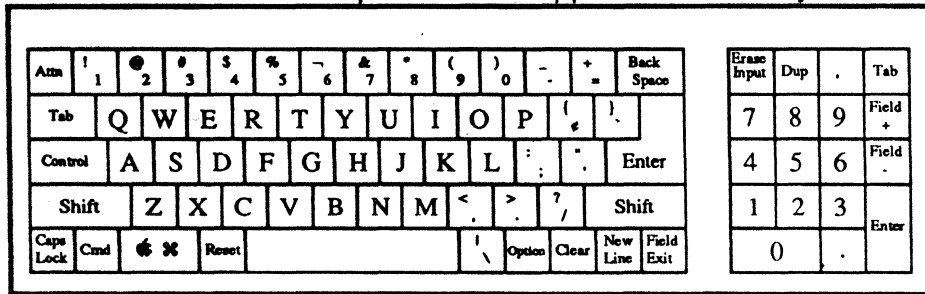
