

IDENTIFICATION: 250-440 TRANSLITERATOR

AUTHOR: W. E. Glynn

PURPOSE: To print a program tape that has been punched in 440 alphanumeric code. To repunch a tape in 440 alphanumeric code that has previously been punched in 250 alphanumeric code.

LOADING:

- a. OUP must be in line one.
- b. To load the program under OUP control, type "F".
- c. Program automatically transfers to start when loading is finished.
- d. To restart when program is in machine, type "T".

USE:

- a. To print a program tape that has been punched in 440 alphanumeric code, type "R".
- b. To repunch a tape in 440 alphanumeric code that has previously been punched in 250 alphanumeric code, type "P".
- c. No halt is used after either option and it is necessary to use the ENABLE and/or initialize to stop the program.

STORAGE: The program occupies all of lines 2, 3 and 15, and sectors 000 through 065 of line 4.

TIMING: Program operates at Flexowriter speed approximately 10 characters per second.
