bv-Control for Microsoft Exchange v7.0

Automated Management of Exchange 5.5 and Exchange 2000 Environments

The BindView® bv-Control® for Microsoft® Exchange v7.0 software solution offers a host of new features for the Exchange 2000 and Exchange 5.5 computing environments. Messaging system administrators gain enhanced capabilities for performing automated Distribution List maintenance, automated e-mail policy auditing and enforcement, and advanced capabilities for security assessment, along with server consolidation capabilities for Exchange 2000 migration preparation.

This solution helps reduce the cost of ownership for Microsoft Exchange Servers, including native Exchange 5.5, mixed-mode Exchange 2000, and native Exchange 2000 configurations.

New Features Provide More Benefits

Extended ActiveAdmin Functionality

Version 7.0 of by-Control for Microsoft Exchange offers a range of features bringing new efficiency to managing Exchange environments, whether running in a mixed or native mode.

With this solution administrators can:

- Schedule the application to automatically update Distribution Lists and perform periodic maintenance with scheduling.
- Set up rules to search and find virus instances in the Exchange Server environment, and automatically move, copy, or delete those messages without user interaction.
- Use pre-defined or customized reports on X.400, SMTP, Lotus Notes Connector, and other connectors with the new Connectors Datasource.
- Extend policy enforcement to include Distribution Lists and Public Folders with additional ActiveAdmin fields on these objects.

Mailbox Moves

System administrators will increase their daily productivity and ease their workload with increased functionality in managing Exchange mailboxes. They can:

- Use query results to identify mailboxes to be moved, and then drag-and-drop mailboxes between Exchange 5.5 organizations, or between Exchange 5.5 and Exchange 2000 within the same site from within query results.
- Provide mailbox moves on foreign Exchange Servers and maintain translation of mailbox folder names.

Enhanced Out-of-the-Box Reporting

Administrators benefit from a variety of new reporting capabilities, pre-packaged with v7.0. They can:

- View all Exchange object properties using Dialog Books from query results or from Server and Global Address List (GAL) Browsers.
- Report on Connectors with a new datasource. Connectors include SMTP, X.400, Lotus Notes, and Administrative and Routing Groups.
