1 Overview

The Matrox Maevox Firmware Update Utility enables you to update the firmware of your Matrox Maevox product through an intuitive user interface.

Note: Your Matrox Maevox product may ship with an older firmware version. Before using your Maevox product, you must update the firmware version installed on your unit to use the latest version. All Maevox units on a Maevox network must use the same firmware version.

1.1 Supported operating systems

The Matrox Maevox firmware update utility supports the following operating systems:

- Windows® 8 (32-bit, 64-bit)
- Windows® Server® 2012
- Windows® 7 (32-bit, 64-bit)
- Windows® Server® 2008 R2

1.2 Before you begin

Before you update the firmware on your Maevox units, read the following guidelines:

- Make sure you're running the latest version of the Matrox Maevox Firmware Update Utility.
- Make sure Microsoft .NET Framework version 4.5 is installed on your system.
- Make sure you have a DHCP (Dynamic Host Configuration Protocol) server on an established network.
- Make sure the latest version of Matrox PowerStream software is installed on your system.
- Close any programs that may be running (such as PowerStream).
- Stop all encoding and decoding processes on your Maevox units.

1.3 Obtaining the Matrox Maevox firmware update utility

- Matrox makes the latest firmware and update utility for your Maevox product available on the Matrox Web site (www.matrox.com/maevexsw).
- Download the latest firmware package and extract the files to a local folder on your system (for example, C:\MaevoxFirmwareUpdate).

2 Updating your Matrox MaeveX firmware update utility

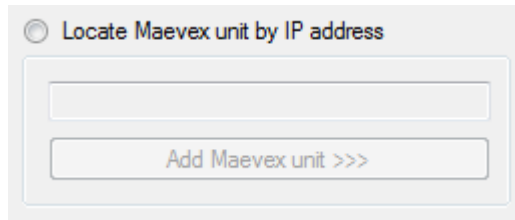
1. Run the MaeveX firmware update utility

Browse to the folder containing the extracted files, then run the *MaeveXFirmwareUpdater.exe* file. This opens the Matrox MaeveX firmware update utility.

Note: If you have different subnets, run the firmware update utility on each subnet.

2. Locate your MaeveX unit using the IP address or search for available MaeveX units

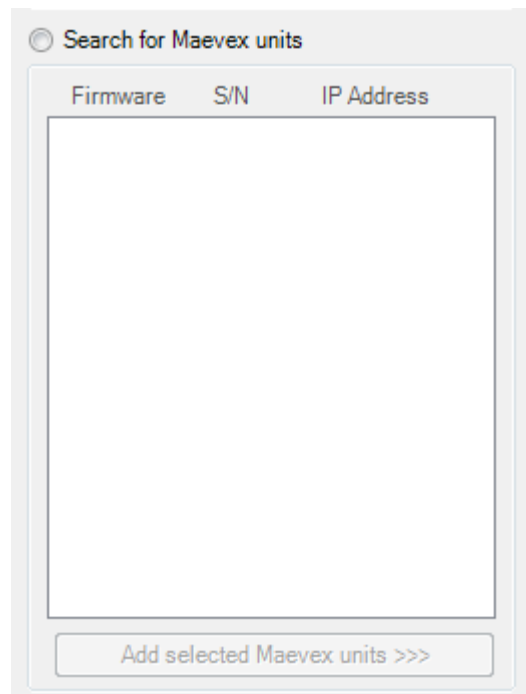
To locate your MaeveX unit using the IP address, select **Locate MaeveX by IP address**, then add the IP address of the MaeveX unit you want to locate.

When you're done, click **Add MaeveX unit** to add that unit to the list of MaeveX units to update. Repeat this step for all the units you need to update.

You can also search for available MaeveX units.

Manually select the units you want to update. Units that have an older firmware version installed will automatically be selected.

When you're done, click **Add selected MaeveX units** to add one or more units to the list of MaeveX units to update.

To remove one or more units added to the list of MaeveX units to update, click **Remove selected MaeveX units**.

3. Update the firmware

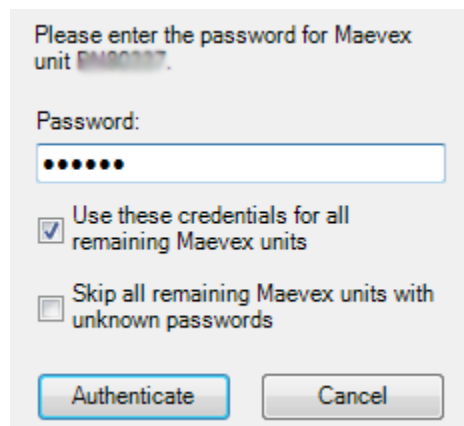
When you're done adding MaeveX units to the list of units you want to update, click **Update firmware**.

Note: Don't shut down your system while the firmware is being updated.

Note: The **Update units in parallel** is enabled by default. This allows multiple units to be updated.

4. Authenticate your selection

If you set a password for your MaeveX units, you may be prompted to authenticate your selection. If you're prompted, enter the **Password** for the MaeveX unit or units selected.



- If you're updating multiple MaeveX units, enable the **Use these credentials for all remaining MaeveX units** check box.
- If you don't know the password of some of the MaeveX units on your network, enable the **Skip all remaining MaeveX units with unknown passwords** check box. Enabling this option ignores the MaeveX units that don't use any of the passwords already entered. Any skipped units won't be updated.

When you're done, click **Authenticate**.

Note: If the firmware update is suddenly interrupted (for example, in the event of a network interruption or system crash), the MaeveX unit will continue to run in maintenance mode. To recover, re-launch the update utility. The update utility will resume the update.

2.1 Notes and limitations

- Running another instance of the MaeveX firmware updater utility from different locations on your network may cause problems with your MaeveX units. To avoid possible problems with your MaeveX units, we recommend running only one instance of the MaeveX firmware updater utility at a time.
