NAME

segname — get name of segment

SYNOPSIS

(segname = 23.)

segname(segid, segnam)

int segid; /* segment ID */

int segnam[2]; /* returned name of segment */

DESCRIPTION

Segname returns the segment name of the segment specified by *segid*, in the two-word storage area *segnam*. A value of 1 is returned from C.

In assembly language, r0 must contain the value of *segid*.

DIAGNOSTICS

A null value is returned from C if the segment does not exist or is an unnamed segment.

In assembly language, the c-bit is set.

FUTURE AND DMERT DIAGNOSTICS

A -1 value is returned from C if the segment does not exist or is an unnamed segment.
